

Licensing and Policies

The Redeemer Preschool Director coordinates the total curriculum with the support of the School Operating Board.

All teachers are experienced and trained in preschool education. Background security checks are required. Two teachers are assigned to each classroom. This ensures a teacher-to-student ratio at or below state guidelines in all classes.

Redeemer Preschool is licensed by the State of Ohio. The licenses, laws, and mandates are available for review by request.

Redeemer Preschool encourages a multi-cultural environment and does not discriminate in the enrollment of children on the basis of color, race, religion, gender, or national origin.



Application Procedures

Beginning January 4, families with children currently enrolled in the school will be given the opportunity to register for the coming school year. On January 10, parishioners and preschool alumni families may begin registration. These applications are available beginning January 1, 2022 at RedeemerPreschoolHydePark.com. Applications must be returned along with your (non-refundable and not applied to tuition) \$85 registration fee (payable to Redeemer Preschool).

Applications from new families will be accepted beginning **January 12 at 8AM. Applications must be hand delivered on January 12. Enrollment is 1st come first served. No applications will be accepted by mail before January 13.** After notification of acceptance, a non-refundable \$100 tuition deposit will be due March 1. Failure to make this payment will forfeit your child's place on the enrollment list.

Enrollment in Redeemer Preschool is complete when the following criteria have been met:

1. Application form has been received.
2. Payment of \$85 registration fee has been made. (This is non-refundable and is not applied to tuition.)
3. Payment of non-refundable \$100 tuition deposit by March 1.

Scholarships

A limited number of partial scholarships, based on financial need, are available. Final approval of scholarships is made by the Redeemer Preschool Operating Board.

No one knows how marvelous your child is as well as you. Each moment can be filled with new achievements. Redeemer Preschool will provide your child with a safe, caring environment filled with learning and fun opportunities.

Attention to each child's needs and potential is part of the Redeemer Preschool success recipe. Just ask our grads! Or, better yet, ask their parents and grade school teachers.

These goals are achieved through a developmental approach to learning and based on early childhood development, to foster your child's curiosity about the world around him/her. Each classroom offers your child an opportunity to experience all areas of development, including dramatic play, nature, music, and age-appropriate cognitive skills.

A weekly chapel service is led by a Church of the Redeemer staff person. Simple songs, Bible stories, and a few short prayers are suitable for a diversity of faiths found in our student population.

School outreach projects are coordinated to help our children develop community awareness and understand the importance of their contribution.

Redeemer Preschool provides bi-weekly music classes taught by a certified music teacher.

Students three years and older are provided with bi-weekly Spanish language instruction.

Emotional and social development is promoted by creating a calm, stable, sharing, and loving atmosphere. Focusing on tasks, making friends, expressing feelings in a positive manner, solving problems, and learning new skills encourages pride and self esteem.

Physical development is advanced by the use of equipment such as the large muscle climbers and classroom manipulatives. An outdoor play area includes a custom-built climber, as well as a sensory table and walls.

Our teachers are always available to address any concerns you may have about your child's school experience. Developmental evaluations are done in January and May.

Parents actively participate in Redeemer Preschool life through volunteering or through sharing special hobbies and interests. Our children are so proud when parents are involved in their school.

Extended Hours

Redeemer Preschool offers morning and lunch buddies programs for children enrolled in the 3-year old and Pre K classes. Morning buddies is 8:00-8:45am and Lunch buddies is 11:30am-12:25pm daily. Contact the Director for further details.

Summer Camp Program

3 (4-morning sessions) are offered in the summer for children ages 3 – 6. Please ask the director for information. Participants must be potty-trained.

2-year old's (Maximum 12 children)

2-day AM Thursday & Friday 8:45–11:30am
Child must be at least 25 months old by 10/1.
Tuition: \$2050

3-year old's (2 classes with 16 children each)

3-day AM Monday – Wednesday 8:45–11:30am
Tuition: \$2300

Music Enrichment 3 year old's (Maximum 16)

1-day Thursdays 8:45-11:30am
Child must be enrolled in our 3-year old class to enroll in Music Enrichment. Tuition: \$800

Pre-K 4 & 5-year old's

(Maximum 18 children per class)

5-day AM Monday – Friday 8:45–11:30am
Two classes, divided into appropriate age and developmental groups through evaluation by the Redeemer Preschool Director. Tuition: \$2650

Afternoon Enrichment 4 & 5-year old's

(Maximum 18 children)

2-day Tuesday & Thursday 11:30-3:00pm
Child must be enrolled in one of our Pre K classes and be 4 years old to enroll in the Afternoon Enrichment. Tuition: \$1900

Enrollment is open to all members of the community. Redeemer Preschool reserves the right to recommend the withdrawal of a child whose needs are not best met by the school. A current medical examination and other necessary forms must be completed before entrance. These forms will be provided after the child has been accepted.
